A Summer Camp For Grades 6-8 of Service, Adventure, and Exploring

Program Information

This program is designed for students in grades 6-8 who are interested in exploring the area around us with master educator Jeanne Warwick. This is a Christian based camp rooted in Christ. We will meet at Selle Valley Carden Schoolhouse at 8am, have some hang out time from 8-9 am and then depart for an adventure filled day to a local park, beach, hiking trail, or mountain. The campers will also have a service project on Wednesdays at the Community Garden on Pine Street to help raise fresh produce for the Bonner County Food Bank. Our outdoor activities will last from 9am- 3pm when we will return to the Schoolhouse for a snack and wrap up of the day. Parent pick up will be from 3:45-4:00 pm each day.

Where: Some of the places we will adventure to include: Travers Park, Pend Oreille Bay Trail, City Beach, Dover Trail, Trestle Creek, Float the Pack River, The Filling Station, Kootenai Wild Life Sanctuary, Schweitzer, Trestle Creek, Sand Creek Trail, The Pilings, Warwick Pond, Johnson Creek, and others. Each day will bring a new adventure or activity, and place to visit.

What to bring: Each camper will need a sack lunch, water bottle, sun screen, and appropriate gear for the day. Before each week you will receive an email detailing the places of adventure your camper will experience during the camp week. If the weather is hot and sunny we may go swimming. If the weather is cool and cloudy we may go hiking, fishing, or huckleberry picking.

When: Camp is Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday in select weeks during June, July, and Aug. Official dates will be available soon. The cost is \$200 per camper per week (sibling discount and scholarships are available).
